Winemaking Clusters are meticulously hand-sorted, followed by gentle destemming and precise optical sorting to select only the finest whole berries. The grapes are gravity-fed into vats and undergo a five-day cold soak to preserve their pure fruity aromas. Extraction is carried out with smooth pump-overs during fermentation. After 30 days in tank, the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally occurring malolactic fermentation in new French oak.
