# HORA

Napa Valley (St. Helena and Rutherford)

**Owners:** Florence & Daniel Cathiard

Grown, produced and bottled by Cathiard Vineyard

<b>Yields</b>	2.5 tons/acre
<b>Average vine age</b>	5-10 years
<b>Blend</b>	55% Cabernet Sauvignon 35% Merlot 10% Malbec
<b>Alcohol</b>	14%
<b>Harvest dates</b>	From September 6, 2022 to September 30, 2022
<b>Harvest</b>	Hand-harvested from our youngest valley floor vines
<b>Winemaking</b>	The clusters are meticulously hand-sorted, followed by gentle de-stemming. The grapes are then gravity-fed into fermentation vats. Extraction is carried out with smooth pump-overs during fermentation. After 15 days in tank, the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally occurring malolactic fermentation in new French oak.
<b>Barrel aging</b>	12 months 40% new French oak
