Average vine age	5-15 years
Blend	55% Cabernet Sauvignon 35% Merlot 10% Malbec
Alcohol	14%
Harvest dates	Started on October 7th
Harvest	Hand-harvested from our youngest valley floor vines
Winemaking	The clusters are meticulously hand-sorted, followed by gentle de-stemming. The grapes are then gravity-fed into fermentation vats. Extraction is carried out with smooth pump-overs during fermentation. After 15 days in tank, the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally occurring malolactic fermentation in new French oak.
Barrel aging	12 months 40% new French oak, 15% large foudres
